Naomi's advice to Ruth V: 3-5
1: Be freshly (wash) <i>James 4:8, 2 Cor 7:1, Isaiah 1:15-16, 52:11</i>
<ul> <li>A. The first step in drawing closer to Christ is we must be</li> <li>B. You can't come to God with dirty hands. So how are we cleansed?</li> <li>C. By the of God. Eph 5:25-26, Psalm 119:9</li> <li>D. By the 1 John 1:7-9</li> </ul>
-The word points out the sin, reminds us of the blood, and the word promises if we confess our sins, he is (Do you know the rest?)
2: Be fragrantly (Put on perfumed oil/anoint yourself) Sg 4:12-14
A. The anointing of a priest meant a consecration. They were set  B. How am I anointed? Your anointing is the 1 John 2:27  C. Do you want an intimate relationship with Jesus? Be to the Holy Spirit.
3: Be fitly (And wear your best clothes)
<ul> <li>A. The Gospel of thelsaiah 61:1-3 Where can I get these clothes?</li> <li>B. Isaiah 61:10 "I delight greatly in the Lord; my soul rejoices in my God. For he has clothed me with garments of salvation, and arrayed me in a robe of His righteousness, as a bridegroom adorns his head like a priest, and a bride adorns herself with jewels."</li> <li>C. Pull some out of your prayers, and shove in some!</li> </ul>
4: Be fully (Uncover his feet and lie down)
<ul><li>A. The most place on earth is at the feet of Jesus.</li><li>B. Can you have an relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ if you are not fully committed to him?</li></ul>
5: Be faithfully (I will do everything you say)
<ul> <li>A. Ruth is not only a hearer of the word, but a of the word.</li> <li>B. If you surrender your will to the Lord, God will teach you. John 7:16-17, 14:21</li> <li>C. Bible study gives you knowledge about God gives you knowledge of God.</li> </ul>
