Important note: Rahab and her family were saved by faith in God and not by faith of a rope hanging in the window. The fact that she hung the rope, made a faith decision, is the proof that she had faith. Faith in the living God means salvation, and faith in His covenant gives assurance; but faith in the token of the covenant is religious superstition and can give neither salvation nor assurance.
