



# MEN'S MINISTRY SPRING ROAD TRIP



## Civil War Battles

of Franklin, Stones River, Shiloh and Corinth

**May 17 –20, 2021**



### ITINENARY:

**Day #1 - Monday, May 17:** Leave COS at 7:30 AM and travel to Franklin, TN. *Trip is 235 miles and takes around 3.5 hours.* After lunch, tour Franklin Battlefield. Then drive to Murfreesboro, TN.  
**Lodging:** Hampton Inn Murfreesboro - 325 N. Thompson Ln, 615-890-2424

**Day #2 - Tuesday, May 18:** Tour the Stones River Battlefield with a licensed guide. After lunch, travel to Corinth, MS. *Trip is 180 miles and should take about 3 hours.*

**Lodging:** Hampton Inn Corinth - 2107 Hwy #72 West, 662-286-5949

**Day #3 - Wednesday, May 19:** We will tour the Corinth Museum and then drive to Shiloh National Military Park, where we will tour the battlefield with a licensed guide.

**Lodging:** Hampton Inn Corinth - 2107 Hwy #72 West, 662-286-5949

**Day #4 - Thursday, May 20:** After breakfast we will head home or take an optional side trip to Parkers Crossroads Battlefield. *The trip home is 313 miles and should take about 5 hours.*

### COST:

**\$250 per person**

**Includes:** lodging, licensed guides, and breakfast at hotels

**Additional fees** for food and reimbursement to drivers for gasoline

#### **Franklin**

Franklin Battlefield includes recently reclaimed portions of the historic landscape and structures that provide visitors a unique glimpse into this bloody 1864 battle.

#### **Stones River**

Stones River National Battlefield preserves the history of one of the largest and most important battles of the Civil War. More than 6,100 Union soldiers are buried in Stones River National Cemetery.

#### **Shiloh and Corinth**

Shiloh National Military Park contains a wide array of historic sites. In addition to the Battlefield of Shiloh itself, the park contains a separate unit at Corinth, Mississippi, that preserves and interprets the Siege and Battle of Corinth. There is also a U.S. National Cemetery located within the boundaries of Shiloh National Military Park, which holds around 4,000 Civil War dead.
